## MEMBERS OF THE 2019-2020 KING'S BRASS TOUR

**TIM ZIMMERMAN** – Director of The King's Brass, Tim received his graduate degree in Trumpet Performance from the Peabody Conservatory of Music of the Johns Hopkins University, in Baltimore, Maryland. He has been a member of the Annapolis Symphony Orchestra and has assisted with a number of orchestras in the Midwest and East Coast. For thirteen years, Tim served as Chairman of the Music Department at Grace College in Winona Lake, Indiana. He has also taught at Taylor and Indiana Wesleyan Universities in central Indiana. Tim and his wife Beckie, have four grown children and live in sunny Fort Myers, Florida.

**GREGORY ALLEY** – Currently, Gregory is the trumpet instructor at Calvin College and Aquinas College in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Prior to teaching, he was a member of the West Point Band in New York for twenty-three years. His music degrees are from Cornerstone University in Grand Rapids, Michigan and Michigan State University. Gregory plays in the Holland Symphony Orchestra, has been a soloist with the Dallas Symphony, Hudson Valley Bachfest Orchestra, and the Montclair Chamber Ensemble. He and his wife Deb, have four grown daughters and live in Hudsonville, Michigan.

**DAN DAVIS** – Dan is currently on faculty at Tennessee Technological University as the Adjunct Instructor of Tuba. Dan received his Masters degree in Curriculum and Instruction from TN Tech and his Bachelors degree in Music Education from Louisiana State University. **SIMEON DAVIS** – Simeon is currently pursuing his Bachelor of Music Education degree at the University of North Texas in Denton, Texas where he studies with Professor Tony Baker. Matt was a featured soloist at the 2018 Reno Jazz Festival and a presenter at the 2017 University of Arizona's Graduate Musicology Conference.
